

EMERGENCY EXIT MAP & INSTRUCTIONS

If it is determined that there is an imminent threat (either natural or man-made) to the citizens of Green Valley, you will be notified by one or more of the following:

- 1. Sheriff's Office or Deputy
- 2. Fire Department
- 3. Sheriff's Auxiliary Volunteer
- 4. Neighborhood Watch Chairpersons or Block Captain
- 5. KGVY 1080 Radio Green Valley

Follow their instructions. If you are told to evacuate, do so promptly. If you are instructed to go to a certain location, go there! Don't go anywhere else! If there is time, take a brief moment to accomplish a few things:

- 1. Turn off all gas, electrical appliances, and air conditioner.
- 2. Take prescription medications with you.
- 3. Take eyeglasses with you.
- 4. Take identification with you.
- 5. Take important papers and cash.
- 6. Have a battery-operated radio available.
- 7. Take special dietary needs.
- 8. Lock up your residence or business.
- 9. Dogs and cats must be on a leash or in a carrier.
- 10. Follow all official instructions and directions.
- 11. Avoid using your telephone during an emergency.

Remember, in an emergency situation:

- Assess the facts
- Keep your head
- Think of others
- Act calmly and directly

Prior planning can prevent an emergency from becoming a catastrophe.

The Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) may also be involved in assisting with evacuation procedures.
